## Conditions of Entry:

1. Each artists may submit ONE (1) work.
2. Work submitted must adhere to the landscape theme and the vision statement: **“Visual representation of landscape remains a living artistic tradition, encompassing a range of interpretation from high realism to abstraction. ‘Landscape’ may include both rural and urban scenes. Work in this exhibit should be as diverse, enchanting and exciting as the land itself.”**
3. No identifying marks including signatures or initials may be visible on the image.
4. All work must be original AND have been created within the last 12 months AND follow the theme of the exhibition AND not have appeared in an exhibition in the city of Orillia.
5. All work must be framed and wired 1/3 down from the top of the piece using D rings. Artists may be asked to reframe work if presentation is not acceptable. Sculptures must be presented ready for displaying.
6. The maximum framed dimension accepted will be 36" x 48". The maximum for 3 dimensional work is 2 cubic feet.
7. Entries that are accepted must remain on display until July 31, 2010.
8. Shipping of work to and from the exhibition is the sole responsibility of the artist.
9. There is an entry of \$35 that must be received by the Orillia Museum of Art & History with the submission form and CD/file no later than May 4, 2010.
10. There will be a juror's choice award of \$2,000, one honourable mention of \$500 and a People's Choice award for \$300

11. All prizes must be accepted as awarded.

## Entry Rules:

1. The competition is open to any artists residing in Ontario.
2. The exhibition is juried by digital images. Digital files must be jpeg or pdf format, 300 dpi, 6" x 6" maximum, and saved at maximum quality. For sculpture entries please submit 2 images per artwork.
3. Each entry must include:

### **If submitting by mail:**

- A) CD with the digital image of submission
- B) Entry form completed
- C) Cheque or money order for \$35 made payable to the Orillia Museum of Art & History

### **If submitting by email:**

- A) An attached digital image of the submission in jpeg or pdf format
- B) Entry form attached and completed
- C) Phone 705-326-2159 with credit card number and expiry date to be processed for \$35.

### **If submitting in person:**

- A) CD with digital image of submission
  - B) Entry form completed
  - C) Payment of \$35 can be made by debit, credit, cash or cheque.
4. Payment must be received before application is processed.

5. The digital jurying will be the final selection for works accepted to the show.

6. Only successful entrants will be notified.

7. Award winners will be announced at the exhibition opening on Saturday, June 5, 2010. People's Choice award will be announced after tabulation of voting on the last day of the exhibition.

8. Accepted works must be received by the Orillia Museum of Art & History, 30 Peter St. South, Orillia, Ontario, L3V 5A9, between May 25 and May 29, 2010. All artworks will be insured by OMAH while in the organizers' possession.

9. The artist's name, the work's title and medium, and a contact number must be affixed to the work. Unidentifiable work will not be included in the final exhibition.

10. After August 6, 2010, pieces are no longer insured by the Orillia Museum of Art & History.

11. Sales: Should an artist choose to have their work for sale, a 30% commission is deducted from the sale price. The artist must include this commission in the price they set and record that price on the entry form.
